Princess Gerarda-De-Orleans Borbon of Spain has graciously donated for the construction of TMSEG Hostel building for Girls at City of Education.



#### **Educational Literature**





## TM School Beautification Program (TMSBP)

TMSBP is the project of TMF that aims to give students the awareness of their surroundings at City of Education. The School beautification Program is a plan to replicate the message of ideals, objectives and mission of TMF's Educate Pakistan theme in the schools. To inculcate the importance of good citizenship, TMSBP will encourage and ensure students' participation in extra curricular activities like class decoration competition and plantation day.

The program will comprise of maintaing the general outlook of the campus as well as inside the classrooms. It will include the use of directional boards, block names and numbers, formation of pavements that will link the buildings together, sign boards and motivational sayings. A visual gallery will also be designed at TMCE that will present the steady development of our educational institutions and highlight their features. The gallery will be a picturesque description of TMF's success story in struggling and bearing hardships towards the destination.

Ramadan Campaign is launched every year, prior to and during the Holy month of Ramadan. Banners, posters and billboards carrying motivational slogans are exhibited along prominent routes of Capital city. We have been successful in

Around the propitious event of Eid-ul-Adha, TMF invited public to donate their "Qurbani" for supporting the victims of 8th October disaster at



### Nushki Educational Complex

Stretched over 43 percent land area, Balochistan is the largest and yet most backward province in terms of literacy. The situation being depressing, Tameer-e-Millat Foundation has planned to develop an Educational Complex at Nushki, a remote Tehsil of District Chaghi, located at a distance of 144 kms from provincial capital, Quetta. Nushki is situated in a plain at the base of the Quetta plateau, 2,900 ft (880 m) above sea level. It has a considerable geographical and strategic importance. Currently the total population of Nushki is approximately 50,000.



Project details are as follows:

- 1. Justice (Retd.) Ameer-ul-Mulk Mengal, when he was serving as Governor of Balochistan allotted 10 acres of government land for the Nushki Educational Complex.
- 2. According to the project plan, TMF will be developing a Primary School, Two Higher Secondary Schools for boys and girls with residential blocks, sports facilities, library and computer lab etc.
- 3. Development work of Primary School has been initiated and so far Rs.2.5 million have been spent on infrastructure development.
- 4. Completion of Primary school building and infrastructure would require Rs. 3 million

TMF's educational venture will serve to educate the local population, create job opportunities and improve living standard of the community. Other objectives of this project are:

- Promoting quality education through effective teaching and learning
- Character building

After the allotment of land for Nushki Educational Complex, the work pace has been slowed down due to the socio-political conditions of the region. Scarcity of resources is another hurdle in the way of delayed construction. We are hopeful that year 2008 will bring additional local support, community involvement and social sector participation to help us accomplish this aim in near future.

# Tameer-e-Millat School Health System (TMSHS)

Getting the quality healthcare is the basic right of every individual. Realizing the need of healthcare facility, TMF has decided to set up TM School Health System at City of Education. Creating health and hygiene awareness among students, teachers and administrative staff would be the prime purpose of TMSHS. During the second phase this System would

be implemented in the entire TMF educational network. TMSHS will be centrally located in the present building of TM Model School and staffed by a trained male nurse who will offer services like regular medical checkups and nutrition and physical fitness advice. The

School Health System will maintain students' medical record.

Our honorable donor Ms. Fakhira Bajwa has shown keen interest in TMSHS and has made "First Donation" for the project.

The main objectives of this project are:

- To provide medical facility to help improve the health standards of students, teachers and administrative staff
- · To improve the health and hygiene condition
- To train students in health related issues, especially First Aid and Advanced Life Support (ALS) training at 12<sup>th</sup> grade level
- · Identification of health and environmental hazards and taking corrective measures
- To prepare informational / educational curriculum about health, hygiene and prevention of diseases

### TM Urban Model

TMF has planned to establish a modern Urban Model institution in a 12-floor building, covering an area of 12750

sq.ft. in Islamabad. The

building will be equipped with laboratories, IT centre, audio visual library, gym and prayer area. The same model will be replicated in all the major cities of the country. It would contribute towards sustainability of our sub-urban projects.

## Tameer-e-Millat Mosque and Islamic Centre



The motto of TMF schools is to educate as well as inculcate the best human ethical values in students. For the character building of students Tameer-e-Millat Mosque and Islamic Centre will be established at City of Education. The mosque will be having capacity for over one thousand boys and about six hundred women in separate areas. Islamic Centre would have community meeting rooms, Hifz-e-Qura'n coaching rooms and a library. TM Mosque and Islamic Centre will be equipped with well stocked library that would help students to have easy access to knowledge of different religion and their comparative studies.

Tameer-e-Millat Mosque and Islamic Centre will regulate Islamic practices by:

- · Collective praying
- · Reciting and learning Qura'n
- Religious gatherings, like Qura'n Khawani, Mehfil-e-Naat, etc
- · Teaching of Qura'n and Ahadith
- Seminars
